

GENERAL FULL PAPER RULES

All authors are invited to submit a full paper written by the following rules:

- Download and use the **Review Paper Form** or **Scientific Paper Form** to write your full paper, depending on the type of paper you will be writing (Review or Scientific). Follow the specific instructions set explained in the **Review Paper Rules** or **Scientific Paper Rules**.
- 1. The full paper's whole text must be in font **Arial**, size **10**.
- 2. The submitted abstract should ideally contain **no less than 5, and no more than 20 pages** in total, including spaces, paper titles, author names, addresses, and keywords. Shorter or longer manuscripts will have to be discussed with the Publisher before submission.
- 3. No more than **two (2) manuscripts** can be published by a single author **in one volume**.

Definitions:

Original SCIENTIFIC Paper - reports unpublished results of a completed original scientific research by the study's author(s). Experimental data should be presented in a way that enables the reproduction, and verification of analyses and deductions, on which the conclusions are based.

REVIEW Paper - synthesizes, summarizes, analyses, and evaluates published works on a specific topic, as critical surveys of an area in which the author is (preferably) active. By organizing, integrating, and evaluating previously published material, the author of a review article considers the progress of current research toward clarifying a certain problem. Review articles can range from entirely descriptive to highly evaluative.
